All students are expected to know their addition and subtraction facts up to 20 – please continue to work with your child over the summer so that these facts are memorized by the time they return to school – use flashcards, oral quizzes, free apps, etc.

Please do not do any assignments for 2nd grade. They will do some homework and classwork from this website throughout the year. All summer assignments are in the 1st grade lessons.
