To prepare your child for fourth grade math, they will need to complete a math assignment that will be due on the first day of school. Your child should already have a login for IXL. If your child does not remember their login information, please email Mrs. Ruby, but please know that she will have limited email access during the summer.

Listed on the back are the lessons I would like your child to do over the summer. There are 11 lessons. All we need you to do is sign as they complete each lesson. They will receive a 100% as their first math test grade of the first quarter for completing this project. **All students are expected to know their multiplication facts up to 12's – please continue to work with your child over the summer so that these facts are memorized by the time they return to school – use flashcards, oral quizzes, free apps, etc.** Students will take a timed test on all multiplication facts the first week we return to school.

**Please do not do any assignments for 4<sup>th</sup> grade.** They will do some homework and classwork from this website throughout the year. **All summer assignments are in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade lessons.**
