5th Summer Reading Book Review Project

Your summer reading is to read **Wonder by R.J. Palacio**. Most local public libraries have e-book and/or audio book options to check out if you can't get the print version. After reading the book, you will be creating a book review for Wonder. You can create a PowerPoint or Prezi (or any other presentation app you have) or you can make a poster, displaying your review. The following should be included in your review. If you are doing a PowerPoint, each part should be its own slide. If you are doing a poster, each should be in a box or in its own section of the poster.

<h3>Summary</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your summary should retell the plot, including the beginning, middle, and end of the book. (About 2 to 3 paragraphs).	<h3>Point of View</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Discuss in a slide or in a section of your review the point of view of each part of <i>Wonder</i>. (You will notice that <i>Wonder</i> shows first person point of view from various characters, not just the main character.)<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Discuss what you thought of the various points of view.<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Did you like reading from various points of view?▪ Do you think it helped in understanding the characters better?
